PROHIBITED ITEMS	
Air conditioner, heating equipment (e.g. space heater), large  Hot plates, indoor grill, toaster oven, microwave  You may use a kettle, coffee maker, blender, rice cooker, and toaster in the common room, but <b>NOT</b> in your room  Refrigerators (over 5 cubic feet)  Room furnishings cannot be replaced or removed from the room  Pets of any kind (cats, dogs, reptiles, fish, etc)	<ul> <li>☐ Sub-woofers</li> <li>☐ Candles, incense, halogen combustible fuel lamps (contact ORSL about smudging requests)</li> <li>☐ Firearms, weapons, explosives or pyrotechnic substance</li> <li>☐ Illegal drugs and narcotics</li> <li>☐ Smoking (cigarettes, cannabis, vaping, hookah, etc) is <b>NOT</b> permitted in residence.</li> <li>☐ Bikes cannot be stored in residence rooms.
