Placement

This virtual placement position is with the Food Chain Workers Alliance, a coalition of worker-based organizations whose members plant, harvest, process, pack, transport, prepare, serve, and sell food, organizing to improve wages and working conditions for all workers along the food chain. Currently, FCWA has 34 members representing over 375,000 food workers in the US and Canada.

Position

We are seeking a placement student to provide support to our popular education and research programs with food workers. The position will be virtual.

Opportunity

Placement activities will include:

- supporting a participatory research project with farmworkers on the impacts of automation, including supporting focus groups, transcribing interviews and helping with data analysis
- programming support for a food workers summit
- supporting other popular education programming for workers and organizers, including a potential farmworker leadership project with injured workers.

Ideal experience

The ideal candidate for this opportunity would be a student with popular education and/or workers' rights experience, or a student who has had some experience doing community organizing. Spanish language skills would be plus.
