

COVID-19 SAFETY LIST (MARCH 9, 2022)

The province entered the Roadmap Exit Step of its Reopening Plan on March 1, 2022, and as a result, many public health restrictions have been relaxed or removed. With the removal of these measures by the province, the University has suspended the use of the General Assessment Tool (GAT), the EAT (Event Assessment Tool), the SAT (Student Society General Assessment Tool) and the SEAT (Student Society Event Assessment Tool). In their place, organizers of on-campus activities can use this list in their planning. This list and any related policies and procedures will be reviewed and updated on an ongoing basis.

1)	Physical distancing is not required.
2)	Masks are required to be worn in all indoor University spaces and medical masks are recommended. See more information at https://www.utoronto.ca/utogether/masks .
3)	Health screening (complete Ucheck or paper-based visitor form) is required in order to enter the premises of any U of T campus.
4)	All individuals must be fully vaccinated before coming to U of T premises. Resources: UCheck , UofT Guideline on Vaccination . Visitors complete the visitor form which includes a vaccine attestation.
5)	Safety Plan has been posted (Until March 21, 2022): UofT Safety Plans .

7)	Procedures for COVID-19 illness (symptomatic or confirmed) – follow Ucheck instructions.
8)	Infection control measures: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes stations at strategic locations (e.g., entrances, washrooms, kitchenettes, shared equipment areas)• Provision of dedicated equipment/tools• Disinfection of shared objects and surfaces
