Our Career Mentorship Program helps second, third, and fourth-year students explore career paths with New College alumni and friends. We try to match students with alumni mentors who are employed in areas relevant to their studies.

The program is not designed to get a job after graduation, instead it is an opportunity to learn networking skills and get firsthand experiences in the workplace. In past years, mentors have spoken to students about their work and invited them to various activities, such as office tours, observing in-classroom teaching or sitting in on presentations at boardroom meetings.

## **ELIGIBILITY:**

To participate in this program you must be willing to sign a contract agreeing that if we find a match, you will commit to at least three meetings/contacts with your mentor.
