International Programs at New College seeks an individual for one grader position on July 28, 2025 to conduct and grade diagnostic language assessments for incoming students of the International Summer Academy (ISA) in Session C.

Session C Job description

All students enrolled in levelled courses are required to participate in a 3-5 minute live one-on-one dialogue with a representative from the ISA and complete a written diagnostic quiz without aids. These are completed in their home countries before arriving in Toronto. The oral diagnostic occurs through Zoom and the written diagnostic is done by hand and submitted digitally to the program. The graders will administer the oral diagnostics and grade the written diagnostic according to rubrics provided by the program.

Minimum Qualifications

Applicants should have a high proficiency in English language and experience with conducting oral diagnostic language assessments and following rubrics for grading purposes.

Preferred Qualifications

Applicants who have experience teaching Youth IEP or IEP General English courses in the International Summer Academy will be given preference.

Responsibilities

- Setting up Zoom links for oral diagnostics
- Conducting 3-5 minute live chats with language learning students and assessing proficiency according to rubric
- Grading a written diagnostic according to a rubric
- Reporting results to Academic Directors as required
