Our Career Mentorship Program is a partnership in career exploration. It gives second, third, and fourth year students the chance to investigate careers with New College alumni and friends. We try to match students with alumni volunteers who are currently employed in areas relevant to their studies.

The program is not designed to get you a job but rather, it is an opportunity to acquire networking skills and to get firsthand experiences out in the workplace. In past years, mentors have spoken to students about their work and invited them to various activities, such as an office tour, observing a teacher in the classroom or sitting in on presentations in the boardroom

ELIGIBILITY:

To participate in this program you must be willing to sign a contract agreeing that if we find you a match, you will commit to at least three meetings/contacts with your mentor.
